- 1. Visit the Department of Education at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a>
- 2. Create an account or login in to your existing account
- Find all federal student loan information in the federal database

#### Find Info About Your Private Student Loans

- 1. If no loan information is found at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a>, you likely have private student loans
- 2. Private student loans often have a cosigner
- 3. Loan information can be found on a credit report
- 4. Speak to your lender, servicer, or debt collector directly



## Federal Repayment Plan Checklist

- 1. Visit the Department of Education at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a>
- Use the "Loan Simulator" to better understand your options
- 3. Submit an application online or contact your loan servicer
- 4. Reapply or recertify your income yearly or whenever needed



# Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) Checklist

- 1. Visit the Department of Education at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a>
- Verify that your employer qualifies and document employment using the PSLF application
- 3. Enroll in a qualifying federal repayment plan
- 4. Continue to work for a qualifying employer and complete 120 monthly payments
- 5. Submit your final PSLF application
